NYS Pregnancy Risk Network provides evidence based information about exposures in pregnancy. For some exposures, sometimes there isn't enough information available. PRN can refer callers to pregnancy follow-up research projects with OTIS, the national Organization of Teratology Information Services. These pregnancy follow-up projects are designed to increase the body of information available to pregnant women and providers all over the world.

Pregnant women may have the opportunity to share their pregnancy experiences and increase knowledge about a variety of exposures in pregnancy. Research projects include pregnant women exposed to medications or conditions being studied *and* pregnant women who have *not* been exposed. New York State Pregnancy Risk Network (PRN) is

A **free** telephone service that provides up to date information about the possible effects of medications, maternal illness, drugs and other exposures on the developing embryo/fetus. PRN serves pregnant women, women planning pregnancy, their families, and health care providers.

When you call Pregnancy Risk Network you will be asked...

- ❁ The exact name of the medication or agent you're inquiring about.
- ❁ The date(s) when the exposure occurred.
- ❁ The first date of your last menstrual period, if pregnant.

A call to Pregnancy Risk Network involves a brief conversation with a teratogen* information specialist to understand the conditions involved with the exposure. Callers are re-contacted after a review of the available information.



Pregnancy Risk Network will...

- ❁ **Provide information** about the known effects of an exposure on the developing embryo/fetus.
- ❁ **Provide a written summary** of the information to your health provider upon request.
- ❁ **Refer you** to an appropriate agency on an as-needed basis.
